Summer Internship Content Description**

The SAFE (Strategic Alliance to Fight Exploitation) Summer Internship prepares high school students to be informed advocates in the fight against human trafficking. Interns build real-world knowledge, leadership skills, career exposure and community connections while earning service hours for graduation.

- Develop a deep understanding of human exploitation, with a focus on combatting sex trafficking
- Hear directly from law enforcement officers, social workers, attorneys, professors, and nonprofit leaders working on the front lines
- Build leadership and advocacy skills through active learning and community awareness projects
- Gain career exposure across fields including criminal justice, social work, education, and nonprofit leadership
